- Students can only begin studying as a student in the Asper School of Business in September of each year.
- Students applying to Business must complete 24 credit hours, including all required courses (with a minimum C in each) by the end of April of the year they apply to the Asper School of Business to be eligible for admissions under Track 1.
- Admission to the Asper School of Business is competitive; the higher your GPA, the better your chance of admission.
