- Available Program Intakes: **Fall (September), Winter (January)***
 - *Admission to the Winter term is on a space available basis only.
- **GPA Admission Requirements for Advanced Entry:**
 - Students are expected to complete a minimum 24 credit hours including KPER1400 ('C') by the end of April, with 30 unique credit hours completed by the end of August of the application year. Students who need to complete required course and the 24 credit hour requirement in the Summer term for the Fall intake, will only be considered for admission on a space available basis after all other eligible students have been considered.
 - **These applicants must notify the admissions office by email admissions.kinandrec@umanitoba.ca of their intention to complete admissions requirements in the summer term.**
